Update – July 2019

The Yemen SIG has maintained the focus on developing the Yemen Mobile Health (YMHP) Cholera Project as well as involving the Yemeni diaspora in the UK to consider peace for Yemen as a priority objective. We have started testing the images on cholera with the Yemeni diaspora in Liverpool. Participants were keen to take part in developing the project further in the future. We drafted a funding proposal for the project which we will share shortly with potential funding organisations. We have submitted an abstract for the PHE conference 2019 and it was accepted for an E-poster. We have a twitter group @yemmobilehealth and an email yemenmobilehealth@gmail.com.

The Yemen SIG is working with a wide range of individuals, groups and international humanitarian organisations working in Yemen to explore what peace would look like, how to involve Yemeni diaspora and the involvement of the international humanitarian organisations. We also working with UK MPs and MEPs to understand how they could support this work. There was an interactive workshop 'Together for Peace' in Birmingham on 23rd March 2019 involving all these groups. The development of the UK National Forum for Peace in Yemen is an example as an outcome of the workshop.
