- Successful collaboration between FPH, PHE, State Governments of Odisha and MP and Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) in India.
- Contributed to the development of a curriculum for Masters in Public Health (MPH) that was approved by the Ministry and implemented in India through UGC .
- Addressed a gap in public health training of State public health workforce that led to implementation of Public Health Cadre in Odisha.
- The project funded by DfID India, offered excellent training opportunities for UK trainees and consultants with global work experience for PHE staff working with some of the Indian consultants.
- Established and identified Faculty's role in global public health capacity building that could be used as example to other countries, to seek further work.
- Identification and nomination of appropriate candidates for membership of the Faculty is continuing.
- Funding constraints were a challenge, bridged by Support from PHE in covering funding for PHE staff
